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The following guidelines are recommended and expected for all missionaries, both team members and individual volunteers. Long-term and short-term missionaries are not tourists; they go at the invitation of EIM as guests. It is extremely important to be willing to adjust to the expectations of your host while in Ethiopia. Therefore, in consideration of the opportunity to participate in the project described above as a volunteer, and in consideration of other obligations incurred by the mission organization, please review the following agreement and sign below:

- I agree to share my faith in an appropriate Christian manner.
- I agree to cooperate at all times with the team leader concerning our work and life together including daily assignments, food, lodging, transportation, and to stay with the team the duration of the trip.
- I agree to abstain from offensive habits, including but not limited to profanity, the use of recreational drugs, beverage alcohol, and tobacco products, inappropriate dress, pairing off with a team member of the opposite sex, and romantic-public displays of affection while on the mission.
- I agree to abide by the dress code established by EIM.
- Further, I hereby release and discharge the mission organizations which assisted in these arrangements, their agents, employees, and officers, from all claims, demands, actions, judgments, and executions which I ever had, or now have, or may have or claim to have, against the mission organizations, their agents, employees, and officers, and their successors or assigns for all personal injuries to personal property, real or personal, caused by, or arising out of, the above described mission service. I intend to be legally bound by this statement.
- I hereby acknowledge that by engaging in this mission, I am subjecting myself to certain risks voluntarily, including and in addition to those risks which I normally face in my personal and business life, including but not limited to such things as health hazards due to poor food and water, diseases, pests, and poor sanitation; potential danger from lack of control over local population; potential injury while working; and inadequate medical facilities, etc.
- I agree to and understand that team members are responsible for all medical expenses incurred either during, or as a result of any mission trip related to Ebenezer International Ministries, Inc. Further, I have been informed of the requirements of securing travel insurance prior to traveling abroad with EIM.

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Because the primary goal of each Ebenezer International Ministries mission team is to present the Gospel of Jesus Christ, it is important that our team members have a personal relationship with Jesus. As a Christian, you profess that you came to a time in your life when you realized that you were a sinner; that you could not save yourself; you believe that Jesus Christ is the one and only Son of God; that He died for your sins; and you repented of your sins and called upon Christ to save you. Doctrinal Statement of Ebenezer International Ministries (Please Read)

- a. Person of Jesus Christ: We believe in the virgin birth of Jesus Christ. His deity and sinless life. His vicarious death, His bodily resurrection, and in His personal pre-millennial return.
- b. The Doctrine of Heaven and Hell: We believe in the eternal blessedness of the saved in Heaven and the eternal punishment of the lost in a literal place called Hell.
- c. The Doctrine of the Church: We believe that the visible church is a congregation of baptized believers, practicing New Testament principles, believing its doctrine, observing its ordinances, and exercising its autonomy.
- d. The Freeness of Salvation: We believe that the blessings of salvation are made free by the Gospel to all who repent of their sins and accept Christ as their personal Lord and Savior, and that nothing prevents the salvation of the greatest sinner but his or her own inherent depravity and voluntary rejection of the Gospel.
- e. The inspiration of the Bible: We believe the Bible is the verbally inspired Word of God and its revelation is complete.
- f. The Person of God: We believe God is supreme in His person, eternal in His being, absolute in His attributes, glorious in His perfection. We believe in the Trinity.
- g. The Person of the Holy Spirit: We believe the Holy Spirit is the Third Person of the Godhead. We believe that He executes the plan of God for our conviction and salvation. From the time of conversion, the Holy Spirit resides in the body of the believer and empowers him/her for His service.
- h. The Salvation of Sinners: We believe that man was created in the image of God and by choice fell into sin and death. Hence, every person is sinful and under condemnation to eternal judgment.
- i. The Salvation of Sinners: We believe that the salvation of sinners is wholly of grace, and that Jesus Christ is the only way to salvation
- j. The Security of the Believer: We believe that those who receive Jesus Christ as their Savior are eternally secure.



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Team Member Covenant: As a team member, I agree to:

- To do nothing to embarrass or contradict the teachings and ministries of EIM.
- To do nothing to undermine the spiritual leadership of EIM, including its board of directors, volunteers, and paid staff.
