What an encouragement it has been to sit down with our new board chairman, Pastor Jeff Joyce, and spend time discussing the vision and strategic plan for Ebenezer Ministries. We have agreed during his trip to Ethiopia in March we will examine the budget for the Crosspointe School, Ebenezer Healthcare ministries, the construction projects, Mesekel Minch printing, as well as the Evangelism and Leadership training to provide better understanding and planning for the future. I praise the Lord for the Reconciliation ministry that has opened with the government officials. We will be proposing to the Ethiopian leadership a two-and-a-half-year program of training for the Wolaita region, allowing us to train 600 government officials in biblical reconciliation, unity, integrity, and servant leadership

Crosspointe school in Dukem is now reaching 1500+ students in K-9th grade. Ebenezer provides school uniforms, supplies, and meals for 200 of these students who are without parental support, while Ebenezer Health ministries makes sure all the medical needs of the students are being met. The printing ministry has been slowed recently due to a lack of paper, but generous donations of \$11,000 have allowed us to begin printing bibles again. Please continue to pray for these needs to be met so we can get Bibles to the people during our Leadership training and crusades.
