Evangelism and Discipleship – Efforts for 2021 were a tremendous success, after a 2020 year that saw all our trips cancelled. In January of 2021 EIM worked with Doug Huddleston in Sodo area for a leadership training and a church revival. In April of 2021 EIM, along with 36 evangelical churches sponsored a citywide crusade for “Reconciliation and Repentance” in Sodo that saw well over 50,000 in attendance on the final day



with hundreds of decisions for Christ and many local churches uplifted and encouraged. In June, a large team led by evangelist Don Whitt focused on evangelism with over 106,000 people coming to Christ and two large crusades being held. Then in August Don returned with EIM board member, Charles Thomas and their wives and ministered in Awassa for the first time in nearly four years. Ministry efforts there had halted due to tribal conflict. This trip resulted in over 51,000 professions

of faith. A planned crusade in September to follow up the April event was supposed to be led by faithful servant and EIM supporter Dr. Jerry Spencer, but due to health issues he was unable to attend. He provided financial support and the “Praise and Thanksgiving” crusade continued as planned with Haile and the Ethiopian leadership conducting services. The October trip just completed saw a team of 12 hold discipleship and leadership training for 180 churches, as well as Crusades held in the cities of Humbo and Hobicha, with over 15,000 people and 10,000 people in the closing services, respectively. Four days in the market and 27 gospel presentations resulted in over 30,000 decisions for Christ. There were opportunities to share in the prisons, in six local churches, and lead a two-night revival.



Crosspointe School – Things at Crosspointe school are back under way with 1500 students registered and attending. Please continue to pray as Tsedale recruits qualified ministry minded teachers to fill some urgent vacancies. Progress continues quickly, with completion expected within the next 2 months on the new high school that will house 11th and 12th grade

classrooms, a library, a computer lab, and a science lab. Progress is also being made on the new preschool building that has been mandated by the Ethiopian government. It will house 42 rooms for preschool through kindergarten and Lord willing is slated to be completed in spring of 2022. Thank you for your generous donations. The Lord continues to do amazing things at the school through the gifts of his faithful servants.
