Ethiopia and the displaced peoples – We want to begin this newsletter asking that you would join Haile and



Tsedale (and the EIM board) in earnest prayers for their countrymen who have been displaced by the recent rebel attacks in the northern part of Ethiopia.

Though the rebels and the fighting are seemingly being put down by the Ethiopian military, there are over 4 million displaced peoples who are without food, water, and shelter. Humanitarian aid has been limited, and Ebenezer has been able to send funds to help with these efforts and minister to the needs of these hurting, beautiful people “If anyone has material possessions and sees a

brother or sister in need but has no pity on them, how can the love of God be in that person? Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth.” (1 John 3:17,18).

Evangelism and Discipleship – Plans are currently being prayed over and made for at least four trips next year. Trips in March, May/June, August/September, and October are under consideration. These include leadership training, market evangelism, and crusade/ revival services. The March and October dates have openings for going or for funding, as of now, would you consider partnering with us.



Crosspointe School – Everyday work is nearing completion on the new high school building. Slabs are being poured and walls with windows and doors are going in place. Lord willing and things go as planned, the new rooms will be ready for use in January. Thank you for the amazing support for the school construction projects and the salary increases for teachers and staff due to the incredible inflation Ethiopia is facing. The Lord continues to provide amazingly through his people for his work at Crosspointe School.



Please pray with us as plans are under way to make available sponsorship of the orphan children at the school.

Lord willing, he will be visiting the states the middle of January and through the month of February. Plans continue to be for him in the Atlanta area as well as in western Tennessee and North Carolina.
